INVITATION TO BID

The Muskegon Area Intermediate School District is seeking proposals from qualified contractors for the maintenance of parking lots across various district locations. The services required include seal coating, crack filling, and Striping of its parking lots.

Proposals are due back to the attention of Steve Fillmore at Muskegon Area Intermediate School District - South, 684 Harvey Street, STE 202, Muskegon, MI 49442. Proposals must be marked "2024 MAISD Sealcoat Bid," and are due no later than **Friday, May 10, 2024 at 2:00 PM EST**. Bids may also be emailed to Steve Fillmore at the following address:

The Board of Education reserves the right to reject any or all bids received, in whole or in part, to waive any irregularities, and in general, to make the award in any manner deemed in the best interest of the district.

AWARD

The District intends to award the Bid at each district's regularly scheduled May Board meeting (May 20, 2024 at 5:30 p.m.) The district expects the work to be completed by June 30, 2024.

Submission of a bid will be construed as a conclusive presumption that the bidder is thoroughly familiar with the Instruction to Bidders and that the bidder understands and agrees to abide by each and all of the stipulations and requirements contained therein.

The following criteria shall be considered when awarding:

- a. Cost-effectiveness
- b. Conformity to listed specifications
- c. Contractor experience and reputation
- d. References

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- 1. Late bids will not be accepted.
- 2. All bids shall be valid for a period of 45 days from opening.

- 3. Bidder shall provide a list of at least five (3) references (school district references encouraged and preferred) in the State of Michigan with whom they have been providing similar services within the past two years. Names and phone numbers of contact persons shall be included.
- 4. The bidder must clearly state in the bid any exceptions to the enclosed specifications. The listing of exceptions, if any, is mandatory. Any exceptions found in the review not listed could be a basis for rejection of the bid.
- 5. The bidder shall be responsible for inspecting the site of the proposed work and shall be responsible for determining actual quantities of all materials and labor necessary to complete the work as defined below. All estimates provided are included for reference only.
- 6. Preparation
 - Crack fill lots and drives before seal coating. All cracks greater than 1/4" should be crack-sealed. All cracks are to be free of all vegetation, dust, and debris and must be dry to ensure proper adhesion.
 - Power-edge grass away from edges of asphalt
 - Thoroughly clean all asphalt areas to be seal coated so they are free of all dirt, debris, and standing water.
 - Block off work areas while conducting work.
- 7. Seal Coating
 - Approximate seal coat area will be included by location
 - Apply a high-quality grade coal tar emulsion or equivalent seal coating.
 - The seal coat shall consist of two coats.
 - All seal coating must be performed when lots and drives are not in use or with prior approval from the district when the area can be easily blocked off.
- 8. Striping
 - Restripe parking lots according to existing layout. Estimated parking spaces and any special markings will be included by location.
 - Striping must be done when no activities are planned and lots are not in use, or with prior approval from the district when the area can be easily blocked off.
- 9. Bidder is expected to perform all work between May 21, 2024 and June 30, 2024. A variance of this schedule due to inclement weather conditions or if previously agreed upon with the district is allowed.
- 10. INSURANCE Requirements
 - Worker's Compensation at a limit of not less than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for all damages arising from each accident or occupational disease.
 - Comprehensive General Liability Insurance limits:
 - \$1,000,000 per occurrence bodily injury

- \$1,000,000 per occurrence property damage
- \$1,000,000 aggregate
- Comprehensive Automobile Liability Insurance limits:
 - \$500,000 per occurrence bodily injury
 - \$1,000,000 per occurrence property damage
 - \$1,000,000 aggregate
- 11. All equipment, tools, and other apparatus must be supplied by the contractor. The owner will not supply any equipment to the Contractor to complete the work. The contractor is responsible for the working conditions and safety of all equipment, tools, trucks, etc.
- 12. Upon completion, the bidder shall provide a one (1) year warranty on materials and installation.


