## **TECHNOLOGY**

Ravenna has implemented a one-to-one initiative that puts its schools "One Step Ahead." All students have been issued one-to-one devices with iPads in grades K-3, and Chromebooks in grades 4-12. In addition, each district classroom is equipped with a teaching podium which includes a connection for a teaching laptop, microphone, overhead speakers, and document camera. These devices are connected to a wide screen digital projector. We have a district-wide internal wireless network for students and faculty use. RPS networks access the Shoreline Fiber Network which provides 10Gbps Internet access, the PowerSchool Student Information System (which allows parents to view grades online), and a VOIP telephone service.

Ravenna Public Schools maintains a safe and nurturing learning environment. We offer:
