Our three elementary buildings house grades kindergarten through fourth. To prepare students for a larger high school, fifth and sixth grade students



are located at Reeths-Puffer Intermediate and are taught a "team" approach. Students transfer between two teachers in preparation for more movement later in their school career. Reeths-Puffer Middle School serves seventh and eighth grade students, while our high school serves ninth through twelfth graders. As students progress through the buildings, more teachers and opportunities are introduced.
