

Position: Consultant for Behavioral Management
Job Classification: Professional
Reports To: Assistant Director of Special Education

The Consultant for Behavioral Management provides a variety of resources to classroom teachers for the management of deficit or aberrant behaviors exhibited by Wesley School and/or local district special education students.

Qualifications: The Consultant for Behavioral Management must possess a Master's degree or better in psychology or education, a Michigan teaching certificate with special education endorsement or valid school psychologist credentials along with expertise in behavior analysis and developing functional assessments and behavioral intervention plans.

Essential Job Functions:

1. Works closely with school district administrators and acts as a resource to local special educational staff for the management of both deficit and aberrant student behavior.
2. Facilitates the development of individualized behavioral treatment plans for use with students. Instructs teachers in their implementation and assessment. Monitors results and suggests modifications, as required.
3. Provides inservice training and consultation to administrators and educational staff on the principles of applied behavior analysis, positive behavioral supports, behavior modification (non-aversive techniques) and crisis prevention/intervention, functional assessment and behavioral intervention plans.
4. Establishes and maintains contact with parents, guardians and caregivers to obtain consent for specialized programming; to explain procedures and expected outcomes; to apprise of results and to provide suggestions for solving problems in the home.
5. Participates, at the discretion of district administrators, in both the MET and IEPC meetings. Assists in the development and implementation of individual educational plans.
6. Maintains a daily log of activities.
7. Maintains a working relationship and rapport with area human service agencies.
8. Performs such other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as may be assigned.
