## A FISH STORY

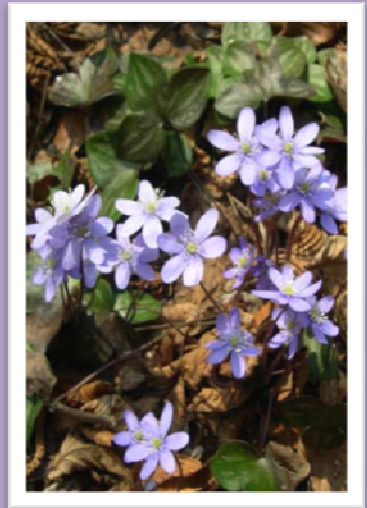
10am-Noon
