Ten students to graduate from Wesley School, star in film

Ten students will graduate from Wesley School on **Thursday, June 11, 2009, at 1:00 p.m.** As part of commencement ceremony, each graduate will “star” in a short film crafted by Muskegon Area Intermediate School District (MAISD) staff. The ceremony will take place in the school’s gymnasium at 915 East Wesley Avenue in Muskegon. The graduates are residents of Mona Shores, Muskegon, Orchard View, and Reeths-Puffer school districts. They have been participating in specialized programs at Wesley School to meet their individual needs. Local school board members, staff, and the public are invited to join the graduates and their family for the special celebration.

The **Wesley School Prom** will be held two days earlier on Tuesday, **June 9, 2009, at 6:30 p.m.** This event features a formal dinner, dance, and decorations. Wesley School alumni also attend the prom each year and reunite with former classmates. The prom is sponsored annually by the Knights of Columbus, Chapter 706.

Wesley School is a centralized special education facility operated by the MAISD. Wesley provides life skills training to eligible students enrolled in special education programs from ages 0 – 26. Students reside in the 12 local school districts that make up the MAISD. Wesley also operates four adult community-based transition centers.
