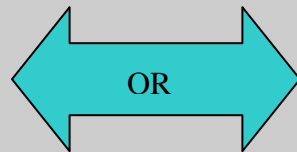

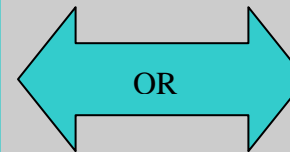
**On –Site Historical Analysis:**
