Ever wish you could make the fonts in that Internet browser window just a bit bigger or smaller? You can.

If you're using Internet Explorer, go up to the View menu and choose Text Size. For a bigger font, select Larger or Largest. To reduce the font size, select Smaller or Smallest. Medium is the default.

If you're using Firefox, go up to the View menu and choose Text Size, then Increase or Decrease. You can also use keyboard commands - Ctrl + to increase the font and Ctrl - to decrease the font size.
