Dear Career Tech Center Parents & Guardians:

Today, a positive case of COVID-19 was reported for a student who attends the Career Tech Center with Group A (Monday/Tuesday). The student is enrolled in a program that meets at the main campus located at 200 Harvey Street. We wish the student a speedy recovery.

The student was last on campus on Tuesday, February 9th, and all possible close contacts have been identified and notified by CTC administration. The positive student and close contacts will not return to the campus util they have completed their 10-day isolation and 14-day quarantine respectively.

I am proud to say all staff and students have been following our safety protocols outlined in our Return to School Plan, including wearing masks and social distancing whenever possible. Since school began, we have increased our efforts to clean and disinfect equipment, light switches, doorknobs/handles, and bathrooms, in addition to our regular cleaning and disinfecting schedule.

This case will be noted on our <u>COVID-19 Dashboard</u> today. Thank you for understanding that, due to medical privacy laws, we are not able to release the name of the individual who tested positive.

As always, we care about the health and safety of our students, families, and staff. Please help limit the spread of COVID-19 by checking your teen <u>each morning for symptoms</u>. Public Health has also provided these reminders:

- Wear a mask (covering mouth and nose) while in public places or if people visit your home
- Limit social gatherings and practice social distancing (maintaining a distance of 6 feet apart)
- Wash your hands frequently, cover coughs and sneezes, and stay home if you are sick
- Get tested if needed

If we all work together, we can maintain a safe place to learn while also providing quality education.
