Participating students must enroll as college students at Muskegon Community College (MCC). Required MCC curriculum will be covered as part of their CTC class. To qualify, students must have 90% or better attendance, a minimum GPA of 2.5, an up-to-date EDP, proof he or she plans to pursue that career path, and the recommendation of their teacher.

DIRECT CREDIT–FAQ (CURRENT STUDENTS)

How do I enroll?

Career Tech Center (CTC) students enrolled in a program offering direct credit through Muskegon Community College (MCC), who also meet the requirements to apply, should follow the steps below to enroll:

- Complete MCC's online application (select Direct Credit" as your Student Type.
- Complete MCC's direct credit enrollment form including signatures and MCC student number.
- Complete the CTC direct credit agreement with signatures (Mrs. Pulsipher has this form).
- Update your EDP information.
- Bring a copy of your high school transcript (if requested).

Do I need to complete any testing?

Some direct credit classes require students to pass MCC Ready to Succeed testing.

Contact Mrs. Pulsipher to find out if your program has a Ready to Succeed requirement.

What if I attend Early College or I am dual enrolled at MCC?

Please avoid scheduling conflicts. CTC Direct Credit Classes are scheduled in MCC's system from 8:05-10:35 a.m. (AM students), 11:45-2:15 p.m. (PM students), or 2:30-5:00p.m. (third session) regardless of the time you report to your high school. Please do not enroll in MCC classes that overlap these times, or we may not be able to get you into a direct credit course.

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
