

Holton Public Schools is a small rural school that is surrounded by a supportive and close-knit community. Our school is known for its outstanding faculty, small class sizes, and high quality facilities. Studies are focused on mathematics, English Language Arts, social studies and science; while also delivering health, physical education, and other electives. We operate a one-to-one computing initiative at the secondary level, where all students are provided with a Google Chromebook. An online virtual academy program supports the non-traditional learning of students in our district. Students also have the option of participating in the Early College of Muskegon County program, which allows a student to earn both their associate degree and their high school diploma concurrently.



Over \$630,000 in scholarships were awarded to the graduating class of 2020. Resident students who graduate from Holton Public Schools and meet the eligibility criteria, will receive the Muskegon Area Promise tuition-free college scholarship.
