All 315 classrooms throughout the district have instructional smart carts to enhance teaching and learning strategies for students. Smart carts are outfitted with state-of-the-art technology including data projector, presentation cart, document camera, interactive white board, and voice amplification system. Engaging and effective blended learning models along with individual assessment learning programs are used throughout all buildings. There are over 4,000 learning devices including Chromebooks, laptops, and tablets. With over 60 computers on wheels throughout the district, students have individual access to these learning devices within their classrooms on a regular basis.
