How do I qualify?

You must possess a valid or expired Michigan or out-of-state teaching certificate, or have 60 or 90 semester credit hours from a regionally accredited four-year college or university to qualify to teach with a substitute teacher permit. (Baker College students need at least 135 quarter hours).

May I choose where to work and which grade levels?

Yes! You choose the districts and the grades you prefer. If you teach at the high school level, you'll choose subjects that correspond with your educational background.

Do I need training?

EDUStaff will provide important health education training required by law. This training consists of online training modules through the Global Compliance Training link on their website. You will also need to attend a 2 hour applicant meeting.

What are the costs involved?

- Fingerprints cost approximately \$65.00 to process. If you have fingerprints on file with a school district, you may use those only if there was not a break in employment.
- Substitute permit is \$45 annually and is required for those without a valid Michigan teaching certificate. EDUStaff will apply for this and you will be invoiced by the State through email.

How do I register?

Visit EDUStaff's website at www.EDUStaff.org to complete an application and to sign up to attend an applicant meeting. There are two-hour applicant sessions held twice a month at the MAISD 630 Harvey Street, Muskegon, MI 49442
