Dear Parents & Guardians:

Today, Public Health-Muskegon County confirmed that a person that attended the Transition Campus recently tested positive for COVID-19. This person did NOT have contact with your child on the bus or at school, consistently wore a mask, did not display any symptoms, and maintained a distance of more than six feet from other participants. This person has been in quarantine since October 21.

For these reasons, Public Health-Muskegon County does not consider your young adult a close contact of the positive case and your young adult may continue attending the Transition at Craig Campus for in-person learning. As always, if your young adult shows [symptoms](#) of being sick, they must stay at home.

Thank you for understanding that, due to medical privacy laws, we are not able to release the name of the individual. Because the person tested positive, this case will be noted on our [COVID-19 Dashboard](#).

While the health and safety of our participants, families, and staff is our top priority, **some participants may not be able to consistently wear masks or social distance due to their physical or cognitive disabilities**. That's why it is very important for you to check your young adult [each morning for symptoms](#). If your young adult does show symptoms, contact your health care provider.

Public Health has also provided these reminders:

- Wear a mask (covering mouth and nose) in public places or if people visit your home
- Limit social gatherings and practice social distancing (maintain a distance of 6 feet apart)
- Wash your hands frequently, cover coughs and sneezes, and stay home if you are sick
- [Get tested](#) if needed

If we all work together, we can maintain a safe place to learn while also providing quality education.
